FAQ

What can we do for our assembly?

Your assembly can include anything! A film, a poem, a song, a dance, or even a play. It is entirely up to you. Just remember to keep it short, make it entertaining and reflect what you do in your school to reduce waste.

Can we use a presentation or film?

Yes. Each group is allowed to bring one powerpoint presentation and music to accompany their assembly. We just need to have a copy of these before the day of the grand final to avoid any last minute hiccups. We will ask you to email these when we confirm your entry.

How many groups can enter?

We can only accept 1 entry per school to compete against 19 other schools at the grand final in March. Your school will hold their own auditions to select their best entry so keep an eye out for announcements.

Why is there a maximum of 10 performer per group?

The venue for the grand final has limited space so we must restrict numbers unfortunately.

What happens once we have selected our entry?

Fill in the small form below and send it back to us via post or email. Next, practice! Then come and present your assembly in front of our panel of judges at the grand final, held at the Hillingdon Civic Centre.
